About the EU Nature Restoration Law/NRL (2)



Article 1.2.

"This Regulation establishes a framework...to put in place effective and area based restoration measures...at least 20% of land areas and at least 20% of seas by 2030..."

Article 16:

"Each Member State shall submit a draft of the **national restoration** plan to the Commission **by 1 September 2026**."






